### **Dave Hill 1.000 word academic biography February 2018**

**Dave Hill** is Visiting Professor in the Social Policy Research Centre in the School of Law at Middlesex University, London. He is also Emeritus Professor of Education Research at Anglia Ruskin University, Chelmsford, England, and Visiting Professor of Education at the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, Greece. He has held other Visiting Professorships/ Scholarships/ Fellowships at Sussex University and the University of Limerick, Ireland.

### **Academic Focus**

His academic work focuses on issues of neoliberalism, neoconservatism, capitalism, education and social policy, social class, `race', resistance, socialist education/ education for equality; critical pedagogy/ critical education/ popular education, Marxist theory.

He currently supervises Doctoral students at Middlesex University and Anglia Ruskin University

### **International Activism**

Dave is a Marxist academic active in different countries, in particular with academics and activists in Greece, Turkey, Ireland, Poland, Australia and USA as well as England, speaking at trade union and left political party meetings and conferences and academic conferences in different countries. For example, in 2017 he taught doctoral students in Wroclaw and Athens. He has advised the Labour Party (pre-Blair) in Britain, the *OLME* teacher

trade union in Greece, and has regularly worked with *Eğitim Sen*, the Education Public Sector Workers Union in Turkey.

### **The Journal for Critical Education Policy Studies**

He founded in 2003 and chief edits the free online peer-juried journal, the *Journal for Critical Education Policy Studies*, [www.jceps.com](http://www.jceps.com), a free online, scholarly, peer-juried international journal that has had well over a million downloads since 2003. The journal is also available in print.

### **Hillcole Group of Radical Left Educators**
